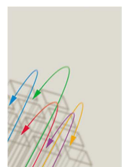

Details on the speed-meeting:

15h30-15h45: Every researcher uses one sheet of paper for each research project (or paper or chapter). On the post-it:

- Name of the research/publication project
- What's already available: research question, literature/theory, data, method,...
- What's still needed: research question, literature/theory, data, method,...
- Two types of needs: advice (yellow) and collaboration (blue). Advice means that the project remains with the proposing researcher who just seeks to reinforce it. Collaboration means that the project is meant to be shared with the view of a co-writing process.

15h45-15h50: All the sheets are pasted on a large board, associating the ones that share one or more features (same type of theory, field, method,...)

15h50-17h00: 7 meeting opportunities for 2 or 3 researchers talking together about either how to reinforce the proponent's project, or how to engage in a co-writing process
